- Supreme Council, 33^o Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite, Northern Masonic Jurisdiction, USA. Where the Sovereign Grand Commander is none other than Ill. Peter J. Samiec, 33°
- The Supreme Council, 33°, Southern Jurisdiction, USA. Where the Sovereign Grand Commander is none other than Ill. James D. Cole, 33°
